



School Uniform Policy

Aims

- To ensure individual safety, by immediate identification of pupils.
- To promote the school identity within the locality.
- To promote the sense of being part of the school community.

Strategies

By encouraging the wearing and use of:

- Items of clothing with the school logo.
- Uniform colour and style of clothing.
- Appropriate clothing for all activities.

Children are expected to be dressed neatly, safely and appropriately for all activities.

No jewellery, make-up, nail varnish or sports clothing is acceptable as school uniform. However, a small pair or single plain stud earring/s is acceptable if ears are pierced.

School Uniform

Sweatshirts / Cardigans	-	Blue school issue or similar colour
Fleeces	-	Blue school issue.
Shirts/Blouses	-	White or blue - collar or polo
Skirts/Pinafore/Trousers	-	Dark Grey or Black
Socks/tights	-	White, grey or black
Footwear	-	Black Shoes or sandals suitable for school activities (no trainers in classroom)
Summer Dresses	-	Blue check
Summer Shorts	-	Tailored, Dark Grey or Black

Children are encouraged to wear a sun hat/cap during the summer

PE Kit

- Trainers for outdoor PE Socks must be worn
 - Shirts - School issue or plain blue
 - Shorts - Black
 - Track suits - (optional) Black or plain blue
- PE Kit items must be in a named drawstring PE bag (or similar)

For Health and Safety reasons:

- Watches or jewellery should not be worn for PE. Studs should be taped or removed.
- Children are expected to change clothes for PE activities.
- Socks must be worn with trainers for PE.
- **All** items of clothing should be clearly named.
