



Sports Premium allocation plan 2016-2017

In the academic year of 2016-2017, Droxford Junior School intends to spend the Government funded sports premium (£8896) on the following initiatives designed to build further capacity in all areas.

Initiative	Reason	Cost
Staff Training	A specialist coach works alongside school teachers to provide development in the delivery in physical education. This allows an increase in teacher confidence and quality of physical education lessons. Funding of courses to develop staff expertise.	£3758
Lunchtime sports providers.	A Zoneparc philosophy in order to provide an organised, safe playground where children have the opportunity to lead healthy and active lifestyles. Specialist sports coaching allows children opportunities to learn, develop and experience different sports (this links into opportunities of school sport).	£3188
School Sport support	School sports teams get the opportunity to work alongside the sports coach to train and compete at level 2 competitions.	£700
PE equipment and resources	To ensure the equipment used is safe and appropriate for each activity. Some of which allow new and wider activities e.g. handball, dodgeball.	£650
Playtime equipment	To ensure equipment which is worn is replaced to support activities at break and lunchtimes.	£100
Enrichment activities	Raising the aspirations of children, especially the disadvantaged by providing a range of activities including visiting a University	£500
