TRAVEL

Children need to arrive **at Droxford village Square** at 9.15am on Monday 12th November. Please be in **Droxford village square** for 2pm on Friday 16th November to collect your child from the coach, or advise us who your child will be returning home with. Please ensure the coach is able to reverse into the car park.

MEDICINES

All medicines, except personal inhalers, should be handed to Mrs Fowler with instructions on Monday morning. Please alert her to any travel medication already taken and/or required before they leave on Friday.

SPENDING MONEY

The children can take up to £5 which will be spent in the shop selling souvenirs only. Please put this money in a labelled envelope and hand in to Mrs Smith the week before the trip.



KIT LIST (attached)

Can I take this opportunity to remind you and your child that mobile phones or hand held games consoles etc. will not be needed. However, please pack books or magazines for those odd spare moments.

I would like to confirm that you will need to provide a single duvet cover, bottom sheet and pillowcase or a sleeping bag and pillowcase for the duration of the stay. The Centre will provide duvet and pillows.

Calshot Spit is very exposed, so the children need lots of thin layers to keep warm. Thermals are a great if you have them.

SWEETS

We would like to ask that children do not bring any sweets or snacks. The reasons behind this are that Calshot provides 3 good meals a day, plus other snacks/fruit. Snacks in bedrooms become a problem at bedtime when children become hyper, stopping themselves and their room mates from much needed sleep. It can also lead to sickness in the night when they don't know when to stop.

Recommended Kit List – Calshot Activity Centre

Children will have limited storage space, so please keep clothes and baggage to a sensible minimum. Squashy bags and old comfortable clothes are recommended, as is a favourite cuddly toy!

- A watch (to enable children to organise themselves)
- Duvet cover, pillowcase and bottom sheet/ or sleeping bag
- Bath towel
- Daysack (rucksack) with a plastic bag as a waterproof liner
- 1 pair trainers
- Wellington boots
- 4 pairs socks
- 1 long pair of thick sock for skiing (knee high)
- Pyjamas/nightdress
- Underwear
- 3 tracksuit bottoms/combat trousers (not jeans)
- 2 jumpers/tracksuit tops
- 1 warm fleece/jacket
- 3 T-shirts/long sleeved tops
- Warm and waterproof coat
- Warm hat
- Gloves (not allowed on dry ski slope without them – woollen are fine)
- Chapstick/Vaseline for lips
- Toiletries – soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, hairbrush, plasters
- Hair-bands for those with long hair
- Reading book/magazine/small game
- Leak proof water bottle
- Plastic bag for laundry
- Torch and spare batteries
- List of kit – useful for repacking
- Pocket money in a named envelope (£5 max.)
- Camera (optional)
- Thermals (if possible)

Children will be responsible for their own belongings. They **should not** take any hand held games consoles or **mobile phones**.

Please ensure all items of equipment and clothing are labelled clearly with your child's full name and they know what has been packed.
